With a quorum present, Lisa Kummerow called the meeting to order at 5:35pm.

MINUTES: It was moved and seconded (D. Kummerow/Tobin) to approve the minutes from the July 28, 2020 meeting. The motion carried with 4-0 by roll call vote.

NEW BUSINESS:

<u>Downtown Façade Improvement Grant-</u> Gina DelRose provided a recap of the four applications received.

Becky Tobin stated that due to the loss of gaming revenues which funds the grant, she was hesitant to approve the request for new doors at 130 South State Street since it did not have an impact on aesthetics or safety.

Sonya Dobberfuhl questioned how historic a building 207 South State Street was and the impact of its façade renovation.

Becky Tobin suggested prioritizing the four applications in case there is not enough funding for all of them.

It was moved and seconded (L. Kummerow/Dobberfuhl) to prioritize the projects as follows: 227 Logan Avenue, 519 South Main Street, 2017 South State Street and 130 South State Street. Motion carried with a 4-0 voice vote.

<u>Promotional/Fundraising Events:</u> Gina DelRose handed out a recap of how the scavenger hunt would be structured, potential sites and asked questions regarding team sizes and pricing. The proposed date for the scavenger hunt is October 17, 2020.

Gina DelRose stated that pricing would depend on the cost of having the box lunches catered.

Gina DelRose questioned if the number of cars should be limited to the number of sites in order not to create congestion during the scavenger hunt.

Sonya Dobberfuhl suggested two cars per site.

Sonya Dobberfuhl suggested having volunteers at the sites to verify what teams succeeded and there should be props at the sites to help tell their history.

Becky Tobin suggested researching St. James Cemetery as a potential site.

Gina DelRose stated that she would contact the Belvidere Daily Republican for publicity.

Becky Tobin stated that she would recommend spending \$100 for prizes.

Sonya Dobberfuhl recommended having first, second and third place prizes. Perhaps local businesses could donate gift baskets as part of the prize.

Becky Tobin suggested reaching out to McDonalds for free ice cream coupons to hand out to all participants at the end.
