Re: Appleton Forcemain Extension – Change Order #1

SegaAg, the contractor for our Appleton Forcemain Extension, encountered bedrock during the drilling and reaming portion of the project. Going thru the approximately 700' of rock took an extra 96 hours to complete. The additional cost for labor, equipment and materials for the extra work is \$143,000.00. The original contract amount for this project is \$300,000.00. This change order would represent a 47.7% increase in the contract. For reference, the second low bid on this project was \$493,735.00.

I would recommend approval of change order #1 from SegaAg, in the amount of \$143,000.00, for the Appleton Forcemain Project. This work will be paid for from the Sewer Depreciation Fund #06-08.

Additional asbestos was found in pipe wrap in the one-story addition on the west end of the Leath Building. This asbestos had to be removed prior to demolition as that part of the building was structurally safe to do so. The asbestos was abated by Ironwood Environmental in accordance with all applicable USEPA/NESHAPS, OSHA and IDPH regulations. The cost of the abatement was \$7,875.00.

Re: Well #5 Update

Cahoy Pump Service has completed the airlifting of well #5. All of the sediment buildup in the well has been removed. They have also completed their inspection of the pump and motor. Excessive wear in the pump will require replacement (see attached pictures). Based on the pumping history of this well, we believe that lowering the GPM output of this well from 800 to 550 will increase the durability of this well. The pump can be reduced from 9 stages to 4 stages and the motor can be reduced from 100HP to 75HP. Attached to this memo is the proposal from Cahoy for the new pump and motor in the amount of \$34,952.00.

I would recommend approval of the proposal from Cahoy Pump Service, in the amount of \$34,952.00, for the new pump and motor at Well #5.

This work will be paid for from the Water Depreciation Account (#04-09).





Re: Bucket Truck Replacement

The boom on our 2005 Ford F750 bucket truck has a split in it and needs to be replaced. The replacement cost is estimated to be \$28,107.59. The current Street Department budget includes \$155,000 for the replacement of our 1988 Mack utility truck.

Given the age of the bucket assembly and the cost to repair it, we would propose to replace the 1988 Mack with the 2005 cab & chassis from our current bucket truck and purchase a replacement bucket truck. We have been looking for new or like-new used models and believe we can find a suitable replacement bucket truck for the \$155,000 budgeted.

In the likelihood that we will need to purchase a used truck, I would recommend waiving the bidding requirement of Section 2-700 of the Belvidere Code.

Therefore, I would recommend the following motions:

Motion #1: Motion to waive the competitive proposal process of Section 2-700 of the Belvidere Code with respect to the purchase of a bucket truck.

Motion #2: Motion to authorize the Public Works Department to purchase a bucket truck for the Street Department at a cost not-to-exceed the \$155,000 budgeted. This truck will be paid for from line item #41-5-752-8300.



Re:

Illegal Dumping

As you know a recurring problem for the City is dumping of garbage and debris within the terrace (the area between the sidewalk and paved street). This are is city owned and not technically a part of the adjacent owner's land. Current ordinances prohibit dumping of garbage in any right-of-way, including the terrace. The problem arises in that we typically cannot prove who illegally deposited material in the terrace. Attached is an ordinance that may help alleviate the issue. It creates a rebuttable presumption that materials dumped in the terrace were dumped by, or with the permission of, the owner or tenant of property. It then allows a method for the City to hopefully recover at least some of the cost of cleaning up the terrace. While the proposal attempts to create a lien process we will most likely rely upon a court process to ensure compliance and recover costs.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Motion to amend section 98-15 of the City of Belvidere Municipal code as set forth below. This will come back in ordinance form.

Sec. 98-15. Depositing material on city right-of-way.

- (a) It is unlawful to deposit on any City right-of-way or other public place, any trash, rubbish, debris, or any material, of any kind. The term right-of way shall include any street, highway, alley, sidewalk or the public space lying adjacent to any street, highway or alley (the Terrace). This section shall not apply to garbage collection in accordance with Section 94-112 of the City of Belvidere Municipal Code.
- (b) The Owner, the Owner's agent or any occupant or tenant of any real property, immediately adjacent to any right-of-way or public place, shall not allow any person to violate subsection (a) of this section nor allow the accumulation of any trash, rubbish, debris or other material within such right-of-way or public place. The Owner, Owner's agent, occupant or tenant of such real property shall immediately remove any trash, rubbish, debris or other material from the right-of-way or public place immediately adjacent to such real property. The presence of any trash, rubbish, debris or any other material within the any such right-of-way or public place, other than a de minimis accumulation, shall be prima facie evidence of a violation of this subsection (b). As such, if there is an accumulation of any trash, rubbish, debris or other material on a right-of-way or public place, other than a de minimis accumulation, adjacent to real property, there is a presumption that the Owner, Owner's agent or any occupant or tenant of such real property caused or allowed such accumulation.
- (c) Violation of Subsection (a) or (b) is declared a public nuisance. The fine for violation of Subsections (a) or (b) above shall be not less than \$200.00 per offense with each day, or part thereof, that a violation exists constituting a separate offense. Further, upon a finding of guilty, the Court shall order the defendant to promptly abate the nuisance unless it has been previously abated in accordance with subsection (d) of this section.
- (d) If the City gives written notice to the Owner or Owner's agent, of real property adjacent to the right-of-way directing the abatement of the nuisance, and the nuisance is not abated within three (3) days of the notice, then the City may abate the nuisance by removing any trash, debris or other material from the right-of-way or public place. The Owner(s) of the real property adjacent to such right-of-way shall be liable to the City for the reasonable cost of abatement. In any action to enforce this section, upon a plea or finding of guilt, the Court shall assess such costs of abatement as restitution, in addition to any fines and court costs or assessments imposed. Notice under this section may be provided by United States Mail, First Class, postage prepaid or by posting a notice conspicuously upon the real property adjacent to such right-of-way or public place. Notice shall be deemed received by the Owner, Owner's agent, occupant or tenant upon the earlier of, the day a notice is posted upon the property or the second day after deposit in the United States Mail.
