Re: Request to Vacate Alley

We have received a request from an adjacent property owner to vacate the remnant portion of the alley located west of South State Street and north of the Union Pacific Railroad, as shown on the attached location map. The original alley was included in Grover Lane's Resubdivision, platted in 1896. The remnant portion remaining of the 15' wide alley is 55 feet in length and is adjacent to 315 and 319 South State Street. The remnant alley is surrounded on all sides by private property. There are no city owned utilities located within the alley.

Based on the above information, I would recommend that the remnant alley adjacent to 315 and 319 South State Street be vacated at this time.



Re: Bellwood/High School Detention Final Design

CES has completed the preliminary design work for the Bellwood Detention Pond and modifications to the High School/Dawngate detention pond. IDOT has given their preliminary approval to allow for storm water detention on their right-of-way. In order to get final approval form IDOT, the hydraulic modeling for both ponds need to be completed. Attached to this memo is a work authorization from CES, in the amount of \$38,750.00, to complete the design engineering for the Bellwood Detention Pond and the modifications to the High School/Dawngate Detention Pond.





Attached to this memo is a work authorization from CES, Inc to complete final design engineering for the West 6th Street Low Flow Channel for stormwater drainage. This project will create a paved low flow channel from West 6th Street to the Union Pacific railroad tracks west of South Appleton Road, maximizing the runoff capability of the channel. This project is included in our current five year capital improvement program.

General scope of work to be completed:

Fees: <u>Lump sum</u> of \$ 28,225 (7.2%)

Final design plans and documents for "6th and Appleton Concrete Channel" in substantial conformance with the attached exhibits. Scope of work: mapping and analysis of the basin upstream of the channel (for max flow estimations) utilizing GIS contours; topo of channel up to 25' each side of centerline; design and drafting of channel (40 scale) and flares at culverts; cross sections at 50' intervals; SWPPP document (along with requisite clearance requests to SHPO and EcoCAT); specifications; bid documents; quantities; Opinion of Cost.

Property line and ROW lines to be based on best available data including GIS mapping and existing plats and surveys; an on the ground legal survey of the alignment or property is not in the scope of work.









Re: Purchase of Vehicle - WWTP

The current budget for the WWTP includes \$25,000 for the purchase of a new mini-van to replace the 2000 Ford Taurus. The Illinois State Bid contract holder for the Dodge mini-van is no longer in business and the State has yet to release a new contract. We have contacted our local dealerships for available vehicles and they have submitted the following:
