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The section of Logan Avenue adjacent to the Crusader Clinic was raised to meet ADA requirements and the additional height requires installation of 150 feet of two block landscape retaining wall to eliminate the excessive slope from the back side of the sidewalk to the existing parking lot. The construction of this landscape wall was not included in the Logan Avenue contract.

STEP 1

### Prepare the Base Leveling Pad.

Excavate the base trench to the designed width and depth. Start the leveling pad at the lowest elevation along the wall alignment. Step up in 8" (200mm) increments with the base as required at elevation change in the foundation. Level the prepared base with maximum lifts of 6" (150mm) of well-compacted granular fill (gravel, road base, or ½" to ¾" [10 - 20mm] crushed stone). Compact to 95% Standard Proctor or greater. Do not use PEA GRAVEL or SAND for leveling pad.



STEP 4

### Install Fill & Compaction.

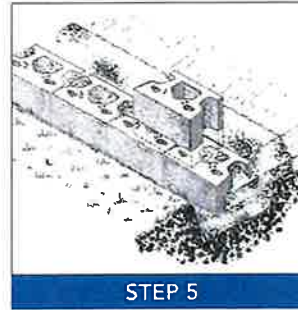
Provide ½"-¾" (10 - 20mm) clean crushed stone drainage fill behind the units to a minimum distance behind the tail of one foot (300mm). Fill all open spaces between units and open cavities/cores with the same drainage material. Proceed to place backfill in maximum 6-8" (150 - 200mm) layers and compact to 95% Standard Proctor with the appropriate compaction equipment.



STEP 2

### Install the Base Course.

Place the first course of Keystone units end to end (with face of wall corners touching) on the prepared base. The receiving pin holes should face upward, as shown. Make sure each unit is level. Leveling the first course is critical for accurate and acceptable results. Keystone recommends minimum embedment depth for below grade placement of Keystone units on a ratio of 1" (25mm) below grade for each 8" (200mm) of wall height above grade or one unit, whichever is greater.



STEP 5

### Install Additional Courses.

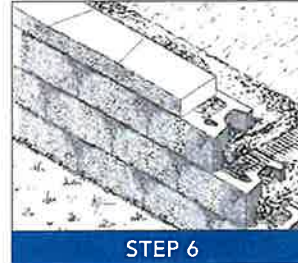
Place the next course of Keystone units over the fiberglass pins, fitting the pins into the triangular shaped receiving hole in the units above. Push the units toward the face of the wall until they make full contact with the pins. Continue backfilling and building to desired top elevation.



STEP 3

### Insert the Fiberglass Pins.

Place the straight fiberglass pins into the holes of each Keystone unit as required. Once placed, the pins create an automatic setback for the additional courses. Place pins in the front holes for near vertical (½" or [3mm]) setback and the rear holes for 1½" (29mm) setback per course.



STEP 6

### Capping the Wall.

Complete your wall with the appropriate Keystone capping units. With units dry and clean, use exterior construction grade adhesive on the top surface of the last course before applying cap units. Backfill and compact to finish grade.

## Proposal for 2023 Annual Services – Belvidere (Boone County) Landfill #2

The following proposal is based on the Background and Scope of Services from the previous proposal for annual services for 2022, carrying forward the activities to be performed in 2023 along with any additional specific tasks that have been identified to be undertaken.

### Background

The current Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) Supplemental Permit (SP) No. 2021-371-SP, dated February 6, 2023 (Permit), requires the continued operation, maintenance, and reporting activities that were required in previous permits. A copy of the Permit is included in Attachment 4 of this proposal.

The Permit requires the operator to conduct evaluation of several organic parameters at a number of groundwater monitoring wells, per Condition 26. In a 2015 SP, the Illinois EPA added 31 new parameters to the annual sampling event completed in April each year. These parameters are included in the First Semi-Annual Environmental Monitoring Report (submitted by July 15<sup>th</sup> of each year) and evaluated in the annual Corrective Action Evaluation Report (CAER) submitted by October 15<sup>th</sup> of each year. If any of these parameters indicate concentrations above background downgradient of the landfill, the evaluation of its distribution, source, and potential natural attenuation could significantly complicate the CAER, beyond the scope assumed in this proposal. The Second Semi-Annual Environmental Monitoring Report is to be submitted by January 15<sup>th</sup> of each year.

In general, the technical support we provide for the City/County, includes the following items:

- 1. Preparation of the Semi-Annual Reports** – Two semi-annual reports are to be submitted to the Illinois EPA. Preparation of these reports include:
  - **Statistical evaluation** – Attachment A, Condition 19 of the Permit requires that groundwater quality data be compared to statistically established background values and groundwater quality standards on a semi-annual basis and that the results of that comparison be submitted to Illinois EPA on a semi-annual basis.
  - **Analytical data** – Attachment A, Condition 20 of the Permit requires that groundwater samples be collected on a semi-annual basis and reported by July 15<sup>th</sup> and January 15<sup>th</sup> of each year. Attachment A, Condition 25 of the Permit requires that groundwater quality data be submitted to Illinois EPA in an appropriate electronic format. Groundwater sampling and laboratory analysis are performed by a consultant/laboratory under direct contract to the City/County.
  - **Groundwater assessment** – Attachment A, Condition 21 of the Permit requires that the first semi-annual report (due July 15<sup>th</sup>) contain, in addition to the information provided in the second semi-annual report, an assessment of the groundwater flow direction and the hydraulic gradients at the facility.
- 2. Corrective Action Evaluation Report** – Attachment A, Condition 23 of the Permit requires that a CAER be submitted to the Illinois EPA as a supplemental permit application by October 15, each year. An evaluation of the efficacy of the leachate extraction system shall be included in the annual corrective action evaluation, as required by Attachment A, Condition 24 of the Permit.
- 3. Air emission technical support** as related to the Registration of Smaller Sources (ROSS) requirements will be provided as part of the technical support services.



TRC's proposal addresses each of these items as well as providing an allowance for general assistance activities that may be requested by the County/City.

In 2021 five new monitoring wells were installed at the site to demonstrate that metals in site groundwater samples are sourced from corroding stainless steel monitoring well screens rather than the landfill. Preliminary sampling results suggest that groundwater samples from these new wells, which are constructed with PVC rather than stainless steel, have significantly lower metals concentrations. These results were confirmed during the Spring 2022 groundwater sampling event, and it will be advantageous to the County/City to have these five new wells added to the groundwater monitoring program as replacements for the adjacent stainless steel wells. This change in the groundwater monitoring program will require a permit modification request.

In addition, the Illinois EPA has indicated that they will consider removing select metals from the monitoring program based on successful demonstration that the metals are sourced from stainless steel well screens. Based on the results from the new monitoring wells, we propose to request removal of select metals from the permit monitoring requirements. Therefore, our proposal includes preparation of a permit modification request to add the five new monitoring wells to the monitoring program and to remove select metals from the monitoring program.

The Illinois EPA has also indicated that volatile organic compounds (VOCs) that have not been detected in any site wells for at least five consecutive semiannual groundwater monitoring events can also be considered for removal from the permit monitoring requirements. Our proposal includes a review of VOC results to identify VOCs to be removed from the monitoring program and inclusion of these VOCs in a permit modification request.

The Illinois EPA continues to evaluate emerging contaminants, with the potential for adding more parameters to all landfills' monitoring programs. A group of emerging contaminants referred to as per- and poly-fluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) are being evaluated by the Illinois EPA. We don't think they will get to the point of adding these parameters to your monitoring program in 2023; therefore, the Scope of Services for 2023 assumes no change in the list of parameters being monitored. However, PFAS monitoring remains an important consideration as part of future discussions with the regulator. We expect PFAS monitoring may be required in the next few years. TRC has a dedicated working group within the company dedicated to research and consultation for PFAS requirements.

## 2023 Objectives:

TRC's proposal has been developed to accomplish the following City/County objectives:

- Satisfy the groundwater data evaluation and reporting requirements of the Permit as specified by applicable conditions in Attachment A of the Permit.
- Modify the permit-required monitoring program by replacing five stainless steel monitoring wells with five PVC monitoring wells installed in 2021.
- Reduce the permit-required monitoring scope by removing select metals and VOCs thereby reducing associated long-term monitoring costs of the landfill.
- Update permit conditions through submission of a permit modification application to eliminate conditions which are no longer applicable/representative of the site.

## Scope of Services

TRC will perform the services described below for 2023.

### Task 1: Preparation of the Semi-Annual Reports

#### **Statistical Evaluation**

Data collected from monitoring wells will be compared to statistical background values to determine whether changes to groundwater quality have occurred. Two semi-annual reports will be prepared. These reports will be submitted by the regulatory deadlines of July 15<sup>th</sup> and January 15<sup>th</sup>. The two reports will describe the results of the statistical comparisons, as well as comparisons to 35 IAC part 620 groundwater protection standards.

The first semi-annual report will include, in addition to the data comparisons and 35 IAC part 620 standard comparisons, an assessment of the groundwater flow direction and the hydraulic gradients at the facility.

Specific activities to be performed include:

- Coordinate groundwater sampling and data reporting with the firm that performs groundwater monitoring for the City/County. We request data to be provided June 1<sup>st</sup> and December 1<sup>st</sup> to allow for time to review data and discuss any analysis report modifications which may be required. We assume that the firm is solely responsible for implementing the sampling procedures specified in the Permit and that this firm will provide suitable electronic data downloads to TRC in a timely manner.
- Perform the data comparisons and prepare reports in the same relative format as 2022. One requirement imposed by Illinois EPA as a condition of reducing the frequency of sampling is to evaluate water quality trends, with the requirement to return to quarterly if there is a specific upward trend in constituents. TRC has included this evaluation in the statistical evaluation. The first semi-annual report due by July 15<sup>th</sup> of each year will include a discussion of groundwater flow direction and the hydraulic gradients at the facility (see Task 3).
- Provide electronically (via e-mail) a working copy of each report for review by Boone County, the City of Belvidere, and the City/County legal counsel. We do not anticipate any meetings will be necessary to discuss the reports and therefore costs for any meetings are not included.
- Revise the report once, finalize the report, and submit three copies of the report to the Illinois EPA, one copy to the City, one copy to the County, and an electronic copy to the County/City's legal counsel.
- Submit the data to Illinois EPA in an electronic format acceptable to Illinois EPA.

#### **Analytical Data**

Field measurements and laboratory results for groundwater and leachate samples will be submitted electronically to Illinois EPA on a semi-annual basis along with the semi-annual groundwater monitoring reports. The electronic data files will be formatted according to the instructions provided on the Illinois EPA Waste Management Web site.

#### **Groundwater Assessment**

The first semi-annual report will include, in addition to the data comparisons and 35 IAC part 620 standard comparisons, an assessment of the groundwater flow direction and the hydraulic gradients at the facility. The first semi-annual report will include a brief groundwater assessment in



the report text and two potentiometric maps based on data collected during the semi-annual field monitoring.

### Task 2: Corrective Action Evaluation Report

TRC will prepare the Annual Corrective Action Evaluation Report required by Condition No. 23 of Attachment A of the Permit for submittal to Illinois EPA by October 16, 2023 (October 15, 2023 falls on a weekend). The report will address the effectiveness of corrective action measures at the facility. The report will contain the following information required by Illinois EPA:

- Potentiometric surface maps showing groundwater flow direction.
- A summary of 35 IAC 620 groundwater quality standards.
- Trend analyses (graphs or trend plots) for chemical constituents that exceed 35 IAC 620 standards, regardless of whether the constituents are included in the facility's Groundwater Management Zone (GMZ).
- A discussion of the nature and extent of groundwater impacts. We assume that there are no significant or widespread groundwater standard exceedances that will require more extensive evaluations or mapping.
- Recommendations for additional corrective action if the groundwater data indicates contaminant concentrations are increasing.
- The results of annual monitoring of the Grenke private water supply well.
- Semi-annual leachate elevation data from gas extraction wells GW-1, GW-2, and GW-3.
- Volume of leachate extracted from the leachate storage tank for treatment at the City of Belvidere's wastewater treatment plant. Leachate volume data will be provided by the City.
- Illinois professional engineer (P.E.) certification of the report.
- The evaluation of VOCs per Condition 26 of the permit.

Based on a request by Boone County, an executive summary section will be added to the report.

Specific activities to be performed include:

- Provide a working copy of the report for review by Boone County, the City of Belvidere, and City/County legal counsel. We do not anticipate any meetings will be necessary to discuss the report and therefore costs for a meeting are not included.
- Prepare the Illinois EPA LPC-PA1, LPC-PA16, and 39(i) Certification forms necessary for submittal of the report as a supplemental permit application. This includes a P.E. certification that will be performed by a TRC professional engineer licensed in Illinois.
- Revise the report once, finalize the report, and submit four copies of the report to the Illinois EPA, one copy to the City, one copy to the County, and one electronic copy to the City/County legal counsel.

### Task 3: Technical Services Support

TRC will provide additional technical services as requested by the County and/or City. These services may include, but are not limited to:

- Additional reports, advice and consultation services for the groundwater, leachate and landfill gas management system, as required and as it relates to areas of environmental monitoring, analysis,

- repair and maintenance activities,
- response(s) to questions from Illinois EPA, as requested by the County Board and City Council, and
- response(s) to questions from the County and/or City.

This task will include air emission technical support related to the Registration of Smaller Sources (ROSS) requirements. These additional services would be provided on a time and materials basis for any work as directed by the County and/or City.

**Task 4: Prepare Permit Application – Replacement Wells and Reduced Parameters**

TRC will prepare a permit modification request to add five new PVC monitoring wells and remove five stainless steel monitoring wells from the monitoring program. The permit modification request will include a comparison of metals results from the new wells and the wells to be replaced. Based on this comparison, we will request removal of select metals from the monitoring program. In addition, the permit modification request will include a review of VOC results to identify VOCs that have not been detected in any site well for five consecutive semiannual groundwater sampling events. The permit modification request will include a request to remove the identified VOCs from the monitoring program.

**Deliverables**

TRC will provide the City/County with the following during the contract period:

1. Two Semi-Annual Statistical Reports.
2. Annual Corrective Action Evaluation Report.
3. Permit modification application and IEPA follow-up.

**Schedule**

TRC will continue to work on this project after receiving your signed Work Authorization. Please refer to Attachment 2 of this proposal for the Work Authorization form.

**Rate Schedule**

The attached 2023 rate schedule (see Attachment 3) has been updated to reflect current TRC personnel categories. Shown below are the estimated 2023 project fees based on the above detail.

**Proposed Fees**

TRC proposes to perform the Scope of Services on a time-and-expenses basis in accordance with the attached rate schedule. TRC will not exceed the contract price without prior written approval from the City/County. Should the City/County request TRC to make changes in the services or to perform additional services (beyond those items addressed in Tasks 1 through 4 above), TRC will prepare a Change Order for acceptance by the City/County. Additional services will also be performed in accordance with the attached rate schedule.

We noted the impeller flange and cooling jacket are damaged, and we cannot guarantee seal at the wet end. Other components are in reasonable condition.

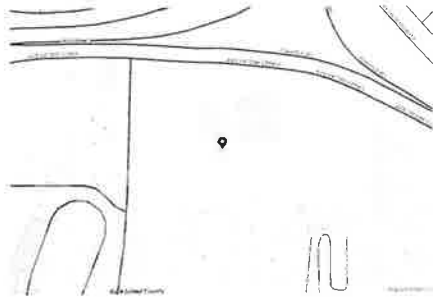

WHEREAS, the City has possession of certain lost, stolen or abandoned bicycles (the Bicycles) within the meaning of 765 ILCS 1030/0.01 et. Seq. as identified in the attached Exhibit A which is incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, the Bicycles came into the possession of the Chief of Police under circumstances supporting a reasonable belief that said property was abandoned, lost or stolen or illegally possessed; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the City of Belvidere agree with the Chief of Police that each of the Bicycles is worth less than \$100.00 and that the interest of the public would be best served by donating the Bicycles to a charitable organization; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find that Empower Boone Inc. is a local non-profit charitable organization that would make the Bicycles available to needy families; and

WHEREAS, the lost, abandoned or illegally possessed Bicycles have been in the Chief of Police's possession for at least six (6) months during which time the identity or location of the owners of said bicycles was not ascertained.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED by the MAYOR and CITY COUNCIL of the City of Belvidere, Boone County Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as if fully set forth.

**SECTION 2:** The Chief and Mayor, or their designee, are authorized to donate the Bicycles identified in Exhibit A to Empower Boone Inc., or such other charitable organization as they deem proper, or alternatively to sell the Bicycles identified in Exhibit A through any lawful means.

**SECTION 3:** If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, invalidate or nullify the remainder thereof, which remainder shall remain and continue in full force and effect.

**SECTION 4:** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 6:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in pamphlet form as required by law which publication is hereby authorized.
