Re: Southwest Elevated Tank Expansion Joint Replacement – Water Department

The following bids were opened today for the replacement of the expansion joint in the riser pipe of the Southwest Tower with necessary structural improvements:

The replacement of the expansion joint is part of the rehabilitation of the southwest tower. A total of \$440,000 is currently budgeted for the rehabilitation which, besides the expansion joint replacement, includes a full abrasive blast and recoating of the tank exterior and recoating the interior wet portion of the tank.

I would recommend approval of the low bid from Jetco, in the amount of \$17,420.00, for the replacement of the expansion joint in the southwest tower riser pipe. This work will be paid for from Water Department Capital Fund, #61-1780.

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE INSTITUTION OF EMINENT DOMAIN PROCEEDINGS WITH RESPECT TO 953 LOGAN AVE.

WHEREAS, the City of Belvidere (the City) maintains roads and streets within the City of Belvidere, including but not limited to Logan Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that reconstruction of Logan Avenue is necessary for the public good and welfare; and

WHEREAS, it is useful, advantageous, desirable and necessary to obtain additional right of way from certain landowners adjacent to Logan Avenue to widen sidewalks and relocate utility poles so as to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (the ADA); and

WHEREAS, one such property is property commonly known as 953 Logan Avenue, PIN 05-36-206-010 (the Property); and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is useful, advantageous, desirable and necessary to acquire approximately 113 square feet of the Property adjacent to Logan Avenue (the Acquisition Parcel) to facilitate the reconstruction of Logan Avenue and the installation of ADA compliant sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, the City has obtained an appraisal (the Appraisal), prepared by Rebecca Davidson establishing the fair market value of the Acquisition Parcel; and

WHEREAS, on October 5, 2020, the Corporate Authorities adopted Ordinance 505H authorizing the purchase of the Property for the appraised price; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director forwarded a request to purchase the Acquisition Parcel to Randy J. Finzel, the owner of the Acquisition Parcel (the Owner) and the Owner of the Acquisition Parcel refuses to sell the Acquisition Parcel to the City; and

WHEREAS, section 11-61-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-61-1) authorizes the use of eminent domain proceedings to acquire property useful, advantageous or desirable for municipal purposes or the public welfare.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Belvidere, Boone County, Illinois, as follows:

1) The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as if fully set forth.

- The City Council finds that it is necessary and desirable for the City to acquire the Acquisition Parcel for the purpose of the Logan Avenue reconstruction and installation of ADA compliant sidewalks for the benefit of the public.
- The Corporate Authorities find that: (1) the Acquisition Parcel is not improved with any structure (or any such structure will be relocated at the City's expense) and not currently used by the owners; (2) portions of the remainder of the property will not be effected by the acquisition of the Acquisition Parcel; (3) it is necessary for the protection of the general health and welfare of the City to acquire the Acquisition Parcel to facilitate the reconstruction of Logan Avenue; and (4) that the value of the Acquisition Parcel in the appraisal prepared by Rebecca Davidson represents the fair market value of the easement; and (6) the Owner of the Acquisition Parcel, Randy J. Finzel, refuses to sell the Acquisition Parcel to the City for the appraised price.
- The City Attorney is authorized to commence eminent domain proceedings to acquire the Acquisition Parcel. The Mayor and City Attorney are further authorized to incur such necessary and reasonable costs to effectuate eminent domain proceedings including, but not limited to acquisition of Minutes of Condemnation, such experts and witnesses as necessary to prosecute the eminent domain proceedings and such other customary and reasonable expenses associated with property acquisition and litigation.

Re: Brownfields Update – Path Extension

One of the items that needs to be completed as part of the cleanup of our brownfield site is the extension of the multi-purpose path from Main Street to Bob's Park on Meadow Street. The path is considered as part of the "cap" on the property. The original plan was for the path to be constructed by our Street Department employees, however, the Street Department is currently tasked with branch pickup, leaf collection and finishing their summer maintenance projects. We have received the following proposed change order from Fischer Excavating to construct the 15" asphalt millings base for the path:

I would recommend approval of the change order to the Belvidere Ponds contract for the construction of the asphalt millings path base at a cost of \$15.60/SY. The total estimated cost of this change order is \$26,832.00 and will be paid for from the Brownfield Grant.

Re: Capital Improvement Program Project Schedule

Upcoming projects on our current capital improvement plan includes the West Harrison Reconstruction Project with an estimated cost of \$2,700,000 and the 5th Avenue Storm Sewer Detention and Relief Line Project with an estimated cost of \$4,600,000.

Given the need for surface improvements to both 5th Avenue and Allen Street, Washington School being immediately adjacent to this project and reducing the frequency and severity of flooding in the neighborhood, I would recommend that the 5th Avenue Storm Sewer Detention and Relief Line Project be scheduled for construction in FY'23 after completion of the Logan Avenue Rehabilitation Project.

We are utilizing \$2,186,000 in grant funds to complete our current capital improvement projects (listed below) which leaves that same amount of capital funds to apply to the 5th Avenue Project. Funding options for the balance of the proposed project are currently being reviewed with the Financial Manager.

Logan Avenue Rehabilitation Belvidere Ponds 6th Street Low Flow Channel Lawrenceville/Poplar Grove Road Intersection

The 5th Avenue Project will include the following improvements (see attached map also):

- 1. Installation of up to a 72" equivalent storm sewer relief line along 5th Avenue from 7th Street to the Kishwaukee River.
- Construction of a storm water detention facility on property owned by Franklin Wire Group adjacent to the Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way.
- 3. The reconstruction of 5th Avenue from 7th Street to West Locust Street.
- 4. The reconstruction of Allen Street from 5th Avenue to 7th Avenue.

The installation of the relief line will require the permitting of a new storm sewer outlet to the Kishwaukee River as well as a permit from the Union Pacific Railroad for a pipeline crossing of their right-of-way. Attached to this memo is a proposal from CES, Inc, in the amount of \$40,437.50, to complete the preliminary engineering for this project. Preliminary engineering will include preliminary design plans, preliminary cost estimate and preparation and submittal of required permits. CES has

also provided an additional alternate design fee of \$68,813.00. This alternate design fee is provided in case the Union Pacific Railroad decides that a tunneling design is needed to complete the crossing of their right-of-way.

I would recommend approval of the proposal from CES, Inc, in the amount of \$40,437.50, to complete the preliminary engineering for the 5th Avenue Project. This work will be paid for from Capital Funds.


