DATA SOURCES

This presentation primarily relies on two sources from the Census Bureau.

- 2010 Census of Population and Housing
 - ✓ Decennial census taken as of April 1, 2010 to provide “official counts.” The questionnaire was limited to ten questions providing:
 - Number of individuals by gender, age, race/ethnic
 - Household structure, relationship of persons
 - Housing unit owned or rented
 - ✓ A great deal of 2010 Census data remains to be released.

DATA SOURCES

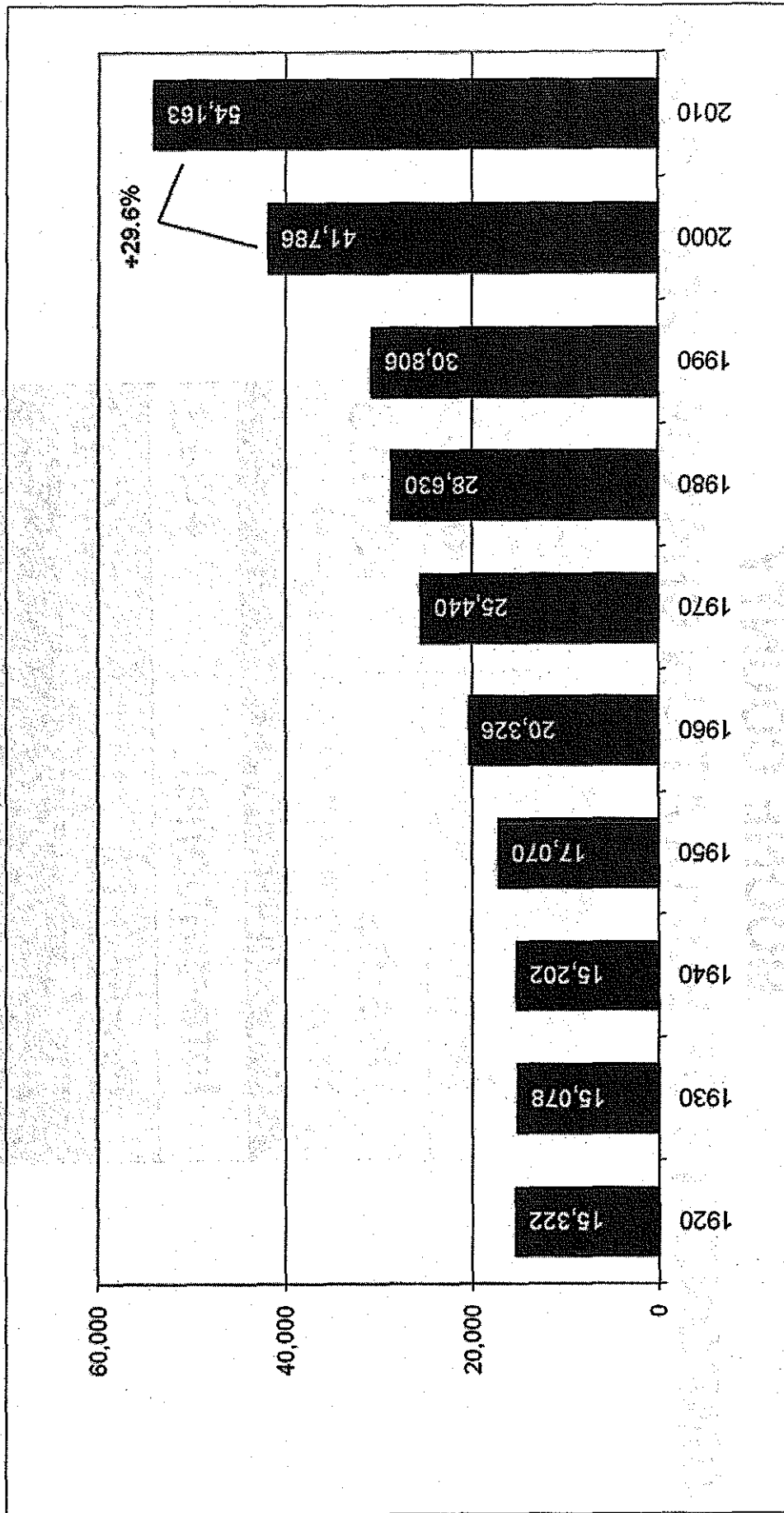
American Community Survey: 2005-2009

- A continuous sample survey that provides annual data. Because annual “margins of error” are very large, five-years are combined to provide data for most geographic areas. Some items:
 - ✓ Family and household relationships
 - ✓ Income and benefits, poverty
 - ✓ Education, employment
 - ✓ Housing characteristics

BOONE COUNTY POPULATION GROWTH: 2000-2010

- × Boone County grew by 29.6% 2000-2010 from 41,786 to 54,165.**
- × The growth of 12,379 was the largest numerical increase ever in a decade, but the percentage growth of 29.6% was a bit lower than the +35.6% from 1990-2000.**
- × Boone was the third fastest growing county in the state behind Kendall and Will.**

BOONE COUNTY VITAL STATISTICS

- × Births rose in the early portion of the decade, but have fallen in the most recent years.
- × The 2009 birth rate of 12.5 per 1,000 population is lower than the nation which was 13.5 for 2009.
- × The proportion of births to unmarried mothers (2008) was 39.8%, up from 27.4% in 2000 and 8.9% in 1980.

- × The Hispanic birth rate is 22.1 compared to 12.5 (2009) for the county as a whole.

MARRIAGES AND DIVORCES: 2009

- × The dissolution ratio (divorces/marriages) is at the highest recent level; marriages are declining.

BOONE COUNTY

COMMUNITY GROWTH: 2000-2010

- × Belvidere with a population of 25,585 is the largest incorporated place in Boone County followed by Poplar Grove (5,023) Capron (1,376) Timberlane (934) and Caledonia (197).
- × Belvidere grew by 4,765 from 2000-2010 which was similar to 4,862 from 1990-2000. Poplar Grove added 3,655 persons from 1,368 (2000) to 5,023 (2010).
- × In terms of percentage growth, Timberlane (+299.1%) and Poplar Grove (+267.2%) grew the most, followed by Capron (43.2%) and Belvidere (22.9%).

BOONE COUNTY COMMUNITY GROWTH: 2000-2010

- × Timberlane was third fastest growing community and Poplar Grove was fourth in the ten-county NW IL area. Davis Junction was first and Huntley second.
- × Portions of Cherry Valley and Loves Park are also in Boone County. (Populations in Boone County not yet issued.)

BOONE COUNTY

RACE/ETHNIC COMPOSITION: 2000-2010

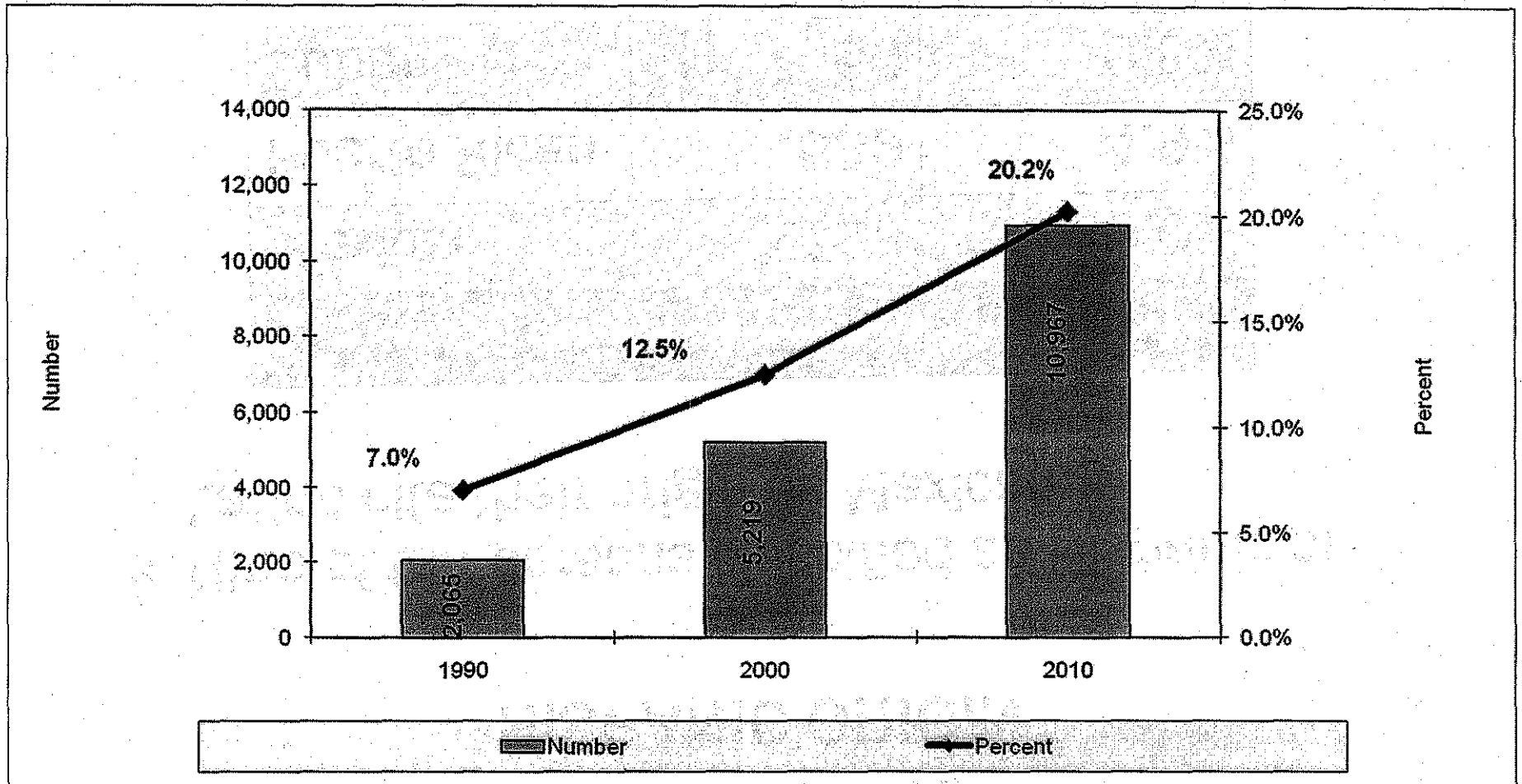
- × The leading race/ethnic groups in Boone County 2010 are white, non-Hispanic (75.2%) and Hispanic (20.2%).
- × From 2000-2010, the Hispanic proportion grew from 12.5% ⇒ 20.2% while the white, non-Hispanic proportion fell from 85.0% ⇒ 75.2%.
- × The Hispanic growth of 5,748 represents almost half (46.4%) of the 2000-2010 population increase for the County. The white, non-Hispanic population also grew by more than 5,000 (5,221).

BOONE COUNTY COMMUNITIES

RACE/ETHNIC COMPOSITION: 2000-2010

- × According to the 2010 Census, Belvidere is now 30.6% Hispanic, up from 20.1% in 2000.
- × Capron (30.9%) and Poplar Grove (15.2%) each have significant Hispanic populations which grew appreciably in the past decade, especially Poplar Grove 1.8% ⇒ 15.2%.

BOONE COUNTY COMMUNITIES

RACE/ETHNIC COMPOSITION: 2000-2010

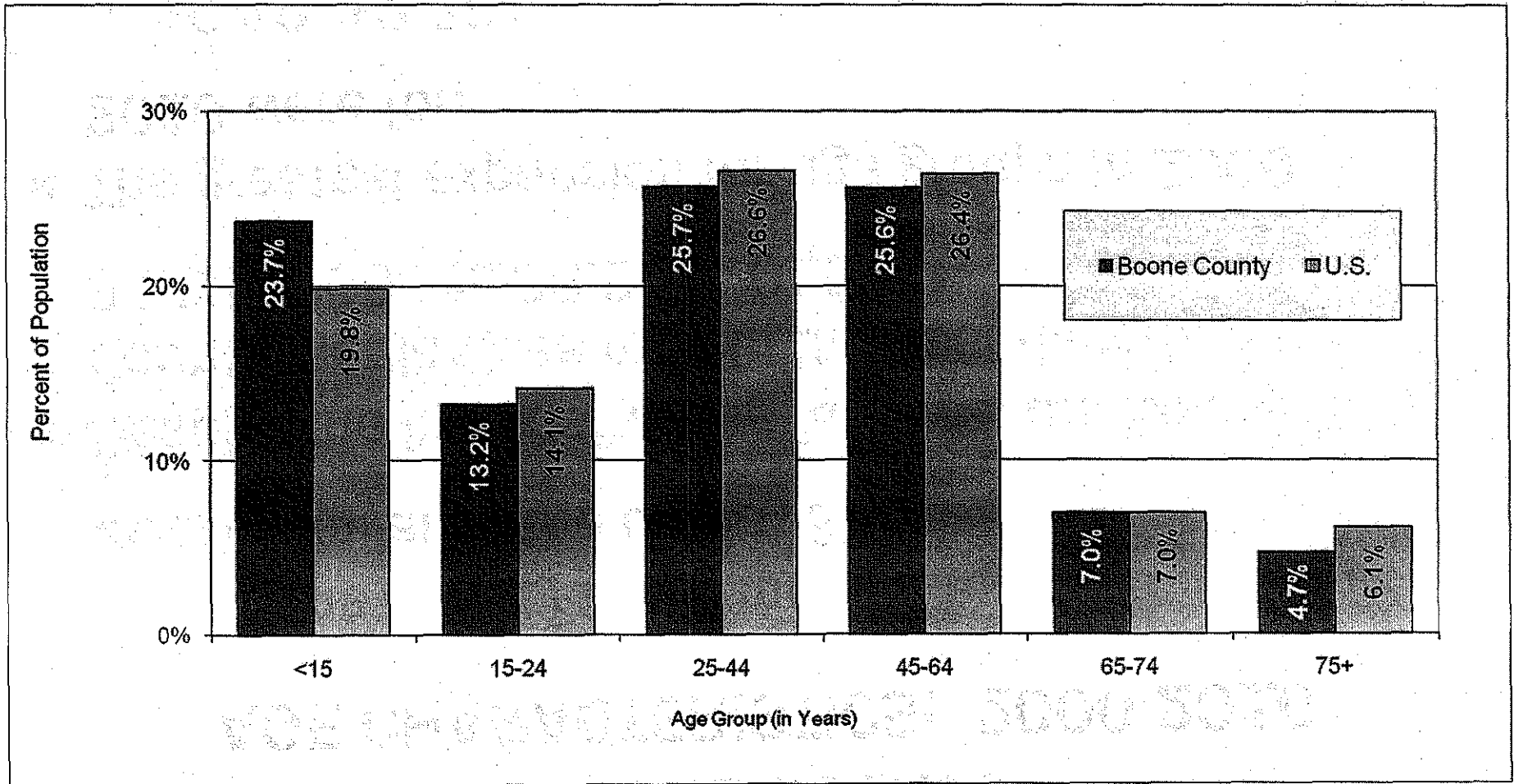
- × The Hispanic population is much younger (median age - 23.8) than the white, non-Hispanic population (median age - 39.1).
- × 85.2% of Boone County Hispanics 5+ speak Spanish at home, 23.1% do not speak English at all or do not speak English well.
- × Half (50.2%) of Boone County Hispanics were born in Illinois, 42.3% were foreign born and 7.6% were born elsewhere.

BOONE COUNTY

AGE CHARACTERISTICS: 2000-2010

- × The Boone County 2010 median age was 36.8 in 2010, similar to the U.S. at 37.2.
- × Despite the influx of young families, the Boone County median age rose in the past decade from 34.5 in 2000 to 36.8 in 2010.
- × The greatest expansion for age groups in 2000-2010 were for:
 - 10-19 +2,361
 - 45-64 +4,739

BOONE COUNTY GENDER

- × Boone County in 2010 was home to 20,909 males and 20,877 females for a “gender ratio” (males per 100 females) of 1.00. The U.S. gender ratio is 96.7.
- × The Hispanic “gender ratio” is 118. Mexican immigration has tended to exhibit a male imbalance.
- × Because women live longer than men, older groups are female dominated. In 2010, for those 85+, there were 209 males, 459 females.
- × Boone County longevity (2007) was:
 - Male 76.5
 - Female 80.6

- × Two thirds of Boone workers are employed outside the county.

- × Boone workers are driving farther than in the past. In 2005-2009, the U.S. average was 25.2 minutes.

BOONE COUNTY

HOUSEHOLD CHARACTERISTICS: 2010

- × Compared to the nation, Boone County has more married couples, but fewer persons living alone.
- × Largest change 2000-2010 was a 3.6% decline of married couples with children and a growth of 2.7% for households containing a senior 65+.
- × Households are relatively large – 2.91 for households, 3.32 for families. Hispanic household are larger, 4.37 families – 4.54. A family is two or more related living persons living together.

BOONE COUNTY HOUSING

- × Home ownership is relatively high in Boone County, 2010 - 80.6% compared to 65.1% for the nation.
- × Vacancies grew in the past decade from 5.3% (2000) to 7.3% (2010).

- × Owner-occupied households (2.95 average persons) are larger than renter-occupied (2.76 persons).

BOONE COUNTY

INCOME AND POVERTY: 2005-2009

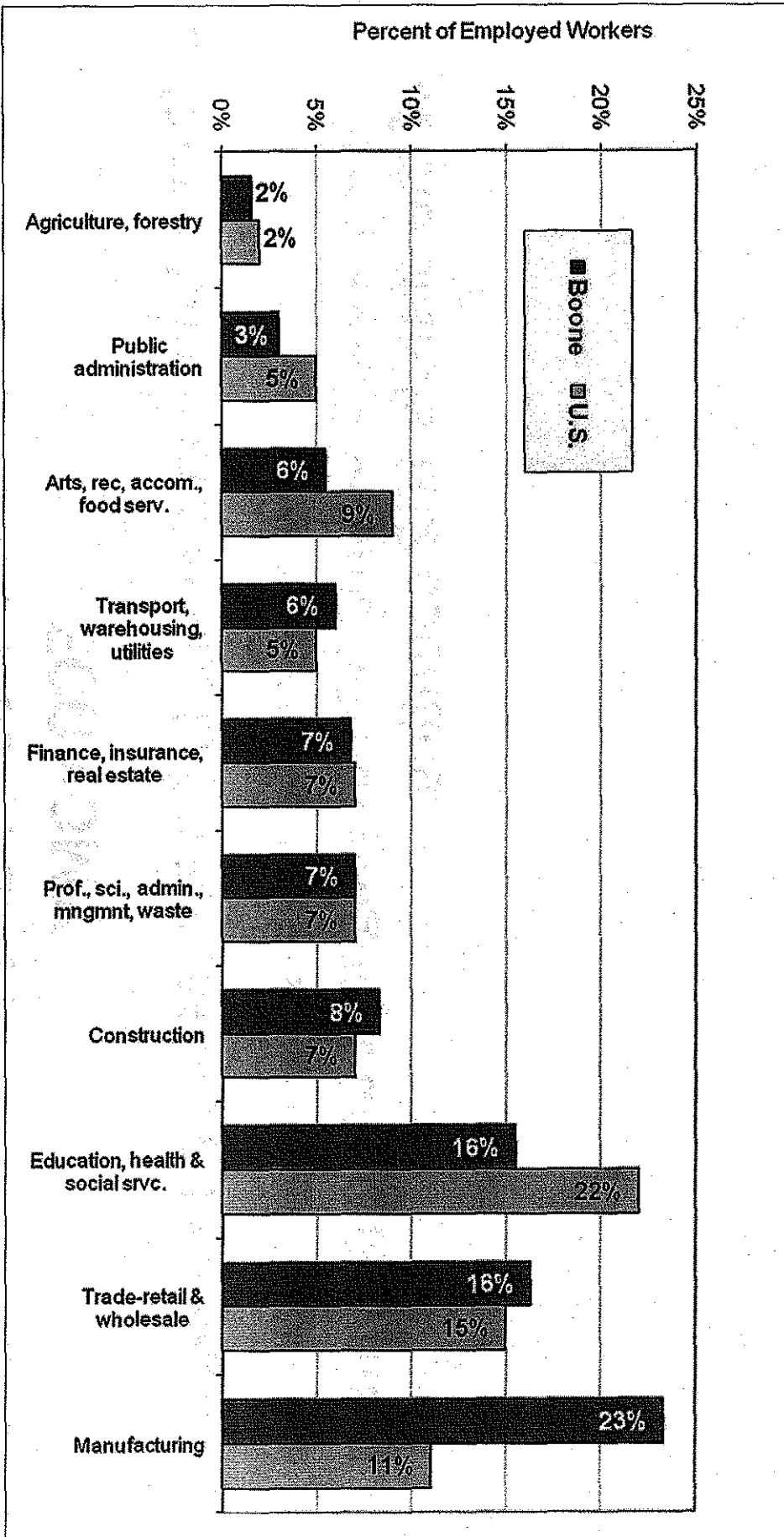
- × Median household income 2005-2009 was \$59,202, higher than Illinois (\$55,222) and the U.S. (\$51,425).
- × Median household income 2005-2009 was also higher than Winnebago County (\$46,882), but less than McHenry (\$77,314).
- × Recent income growth 1999-2000 to 2005-2009 was 12.2%, lower than the nation at 22.4%.
- × 2005-2009 Boone County poverty was 9.8%, well below the nation (13.5%). Highest Boone poverty is female single parent with children under five (70.7%).

BOONE COUNTY ECONOMY

- × **Manufacturing was responsible for 23.3% of resident jobs 2005-2009, double the U.S. level of 11.2%. The manufacturing proportion is slightly higher than Winnebago County (22.2%) for 2005-2009.**
- × **Employment of residents is somewhat “low” for education, health and social services (16% vs.22% U.S.), recreation, accommodation, food services (5.5% vs. 8.8% U.S.) and public administration (4.7% vs. 2.9% U.S.).**
- × **More workers are employed in production occupations (25.2% vs. 12.5%) but fewer in management, professional, services.**

BOONE COUNTY ECONOMY

- × Current unemployment is 10.5% (May 2011), down appreciably from 21.2% in January 2010. For all of 2010, Boone County had the highest unemployment of the state's 102 counties.

BOONE COUNTY

COMMUNITY CHARACTERISTICS: 2005-2009

- × Belvidere (33.6), Capron (33.1) and Poplar Grove (32.9) are “younger” based on median age, though Belvidere has the highest senior proportion (11.9%) along with Caledonia (10.2%).
- × Timberlane (44.8%) and Poplar Grove (37.0%) have the highest proportions of married couple households with children.

BOONE COUNTY

COMMUNITY CHARACTERISTICS: 2005-2009

- ✘ Timberlane exhibits the highest socioeconomic levels based on median household income (\$103,750) and home value (\$296,100).
- ✘ Poverty is highest in Belvidere (14.1%) and median household income is lowest (\$46,600).

Belvidere has the highest poverty rate in Boone County at 14.1%. The median household income in Belvidere is \$46,600, which is the lowest in the county. Timberlane has the highest median household income at \$103,750 and the highest median home value at \$296,100.

BOONE COUNTY EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT PERSONS 25+ 2005-2009

- × The Boone County resident 25+ proportion with a high school diploma is 85.8%, slightly better than the U.S. (84.6%).
- × However, the levels for those with a Bachelor's or graduate degree are relatively low, 19.3% have a Bachelor's compared to U.S. (27.5%).
- × Boone County Hispanics display even lower educational attainment – high school diploma (60.0%), Bachelor's (8.6%).

BOONE COUNTY TODAY SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

- × Boone is one of the state's fastest growing counties, though in-migration may have slowed recently.
- × Movement of residents in and out of the county features an exchange of persons with Winnebago County.
- × From 2000 to 2010, Belvidere grew the most numerically, though Timberlane and Poplar Grove exhibited the highest percentage growth.
- × The "Hispanic influx" fuels much of the growth – Belvidere is now 30% Hispanic.

BOONE COUNTY TODAY SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

- × The Hispanic population is young, live in large traditional families and speak Spanish at home.**
- × Despite the many young families moving in, some aging of the population is evident.**
- × Only one-third of residents are employed within Boone County. Commute times are getting longer.**
- × Home ownership is strong, but housing vacancies grew in the decade.**
- × Incomes are fairly high, poverty low even though educational levels are not elevated.**
